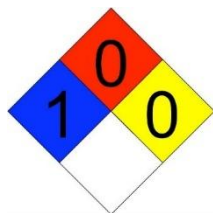

Precautionary Statements - Prevention

Normal for handling of liquids and drum sized containers.

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Precautionary Statements – Response
